Some MCC services like MyMCC require a VPN with a U.S IP Address when you access the website outside of the U.S. MCC does not currently offer a college-provided VPN for student use. Please use the following tips to choose a VPN that will work for you.

Tips for Choosing a VPN

Use the checklist below when evaluating VPN services:

- Research privacy features: Choose a VPN with strong encryption (such as AES-256) and a strict “no-logs” policy.
- Read independent reviews: Check unbiased review sites that compare VPN services for security, speed, and ease of use.
- Consider free vs. paid: Free VPNs may work for light use, but paid options often offer better speed and reliability.
- Verify compatibility: Make sure the VPN works on your device (Windows, macOS, Android, or iOS).
- Test it out: Look for VPNs with a free trial or money-back guarantee so you can try it before committing.

Additional Details

- VPN use is not required for regular MCC services, such as Brightspace, student email, or library access.
- If you are accessing sensitive personal information or using public networks, using a VPN can add a layer of protection.
